

## New Zealand White




## Features

- Albino fur, soft
- Litter average: 8 to 9
- Permanent health control
- The New Zealand white rabbits are very docile. This rabbit is used in toxicological, ophthalmologic, dermatological studies and many other areas of biomedical research
- Caretakers manipulate and socialize the animals as of birth to make them more docile
- Each rabbit is identified by a tattoo in the ear (chips are available upon request)

## Health Control

- Viruses: Rabbit Rotavirus Rabbit pox virus (Myxomatosis) Rabbit phaemorrhagic disease virus
- Bacteria: Bordetella bronchiseptica Clostridium piliforme Dermatophytes Pasteurella spp Salmonella spp Treponema cuniculli
- Parasites: Ectoparasites
  Encephalitozoon cuniculli
  Endoparasites
- Pathological lesions: External necropsy
